In 2019, Eastern Long Island Hospital joined with Stony Brook Medicine to preserve the mission of our founders. A campus of Stony Brook University Hospital, SBELIH provides regional behavioral health programs serving the greater Suffolk County area.

At SBELIH, inpatients are under the care of world-renowned hospitalists—physicians who specialize in inpatient medicine and taking care of hospitalized patients in place of a primary care provider. Centers of Excellence include Medical-Surgical, Advanced Ambulatory Care, Behavioral Health, Emergency, Geriatric, Diagnostic Services, Physical Therapy and Gastrointestinal Services. SBELIH is fully accredited by the Joint Commission and has been awarded the Gold Seal of Approval.

Excellence – We set the highest standards for safety, clinical outcomes and service.

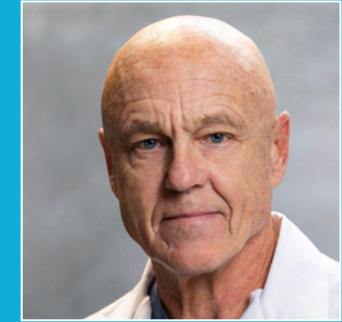

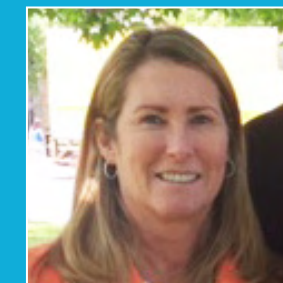

The coronavirus pandemic delivered a rare combination of challenges and misfortune. We are proud to report that with the strength of Stony Brook Medicine behind us, our local hospital overcame many obstacles and challenges— in no small part, thanks to you.

Your generosity continues to shine brightly on Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital. Every dollar raised through the ELIH Foundation stays here, to benefit your hospital and the community it serves.

Fundraising during a pandemic certainly presents challenges however, once again, our community responded to the needs of others and made significant contributions.

Our COVID-19 Action Fund raised \$410,000 and allowed us to acquire COVID-19 testing equipment, an ultraviolet (UV) sanitizing system, a microfiber cleaning system, and more to better serve our patients. Our grand, traditional Summer Gala became a creative “Gala at Home.” The 2nd Annual Fishing Tournament had many boats in participation and is solidifying its place among our annual fundraising events. The 28th Annual Golf Classic, with careful planning for everyone’s safety, has been just as successful as our past classics. And, our 4th Annual 5K Family Walk/Run event became a social media event and raised awareness for our Behavioral Health and Addiction Services.

Donor generosity inspired and moved us in many other ways. One business owner made a \$65,000 contribution so that hundreds of local workers in the community could get free COVID-19 testing. Another anonymous donor pledged \$500,000 for our new MRI, while another came forward with a \$100,000 donation to cover expenses. Of course, it is not just the large donations that count. Literally hundreds of smaller donations are continuing to make a tremendous impact. Your donations have helped purchase over a dozen stretchers and improved, necessary testing equipment. As our community members continued to donate meals, purchase PPE, or volunteer their time, they improved the lives of the less fortunate.

Despite the ongoing challenges to healthcare we are experiencing, we are committed to continuing to improve the services and infrastructure of Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital. None of this is possible without the ongoing support of this generous community in which we live and work.

OPHTHALMOLOGY

A cataract is an opacity that develops in the lens of the eye and limits vision. Cataracts can become more common in people approaching their 60s and 70s. The condition tends to develop slowly, so vision worsens gradually.

Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital is equipped with femtosecond laser-assisted cataract surgery, the latest technology available for precise cataract removal and greater visual outcomes. The computer-guided laser aids the surgeon in several critical steps based on a real-time image of the eye captured immediately prior to the procedure.

Signs and symptoms of a cataract include:

- Cloudy or blurry vision
- Poor night vision
- Difficulty reading
- Problems with light
- Faded colors

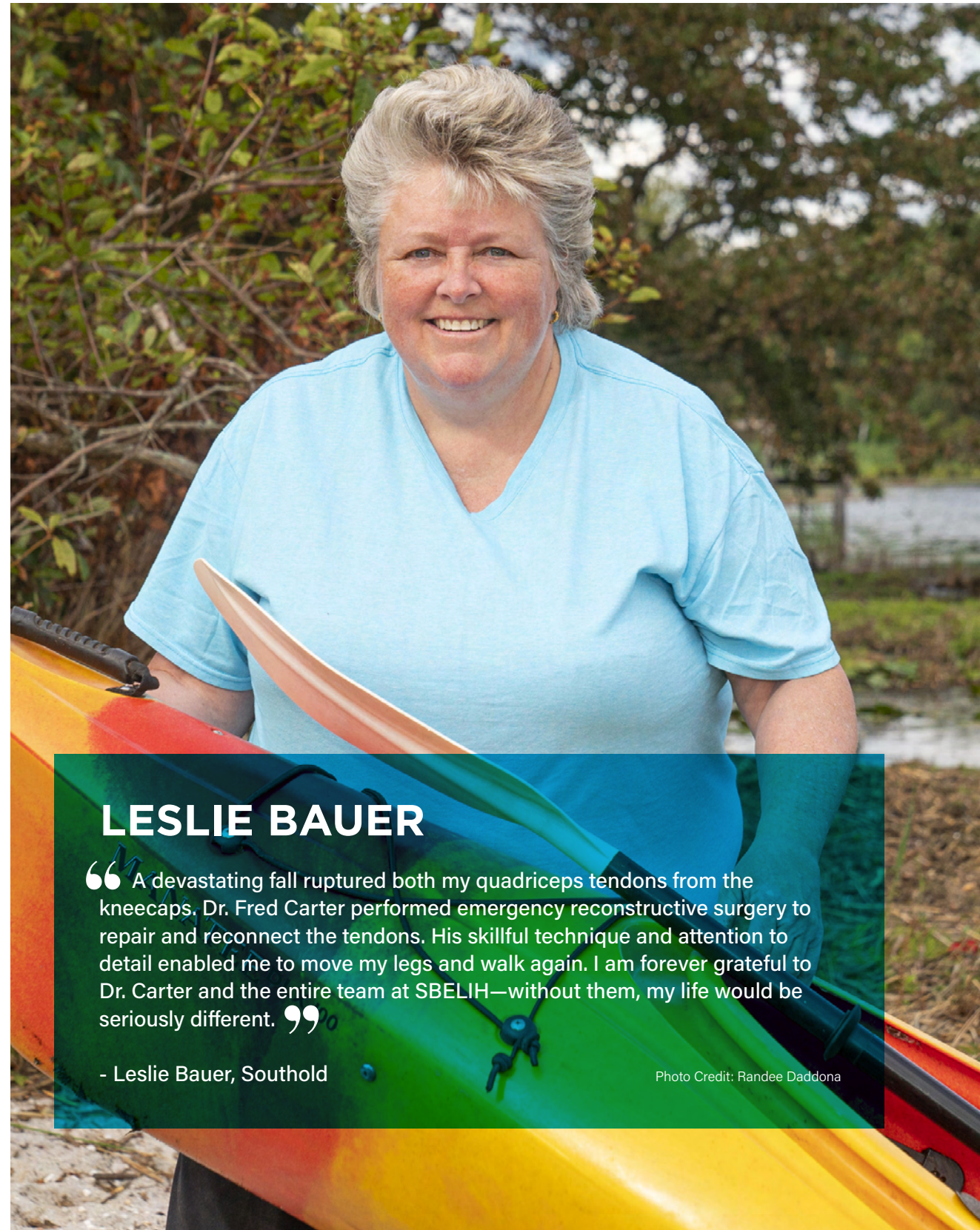

WOMEN'S HEALTH & ADVANCED DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING

Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital is home to advanced diagnostic imaging services, with a new state-of-the-art bone mineral densitometry screening system. SBELIH is also home to 3D tomosynthesis mammography to provide earlier cancer detection, less false positives, and fewer follow-up tests. Our tomosynthesis system is also equipped with a “soft touch” pad for more comfortable mammograms.

The American Cancer Society recommends routine mammography exams for women ages 45 to 54 every year. If you are 65 or older, or if you're younger than 65 but have one or more of the risk factors associated with osteoporosis, you should have a bone density test. If you have a family history of breast cancer or osteoporosis, talk to your physician about when to begin mammography and bone density screenings.

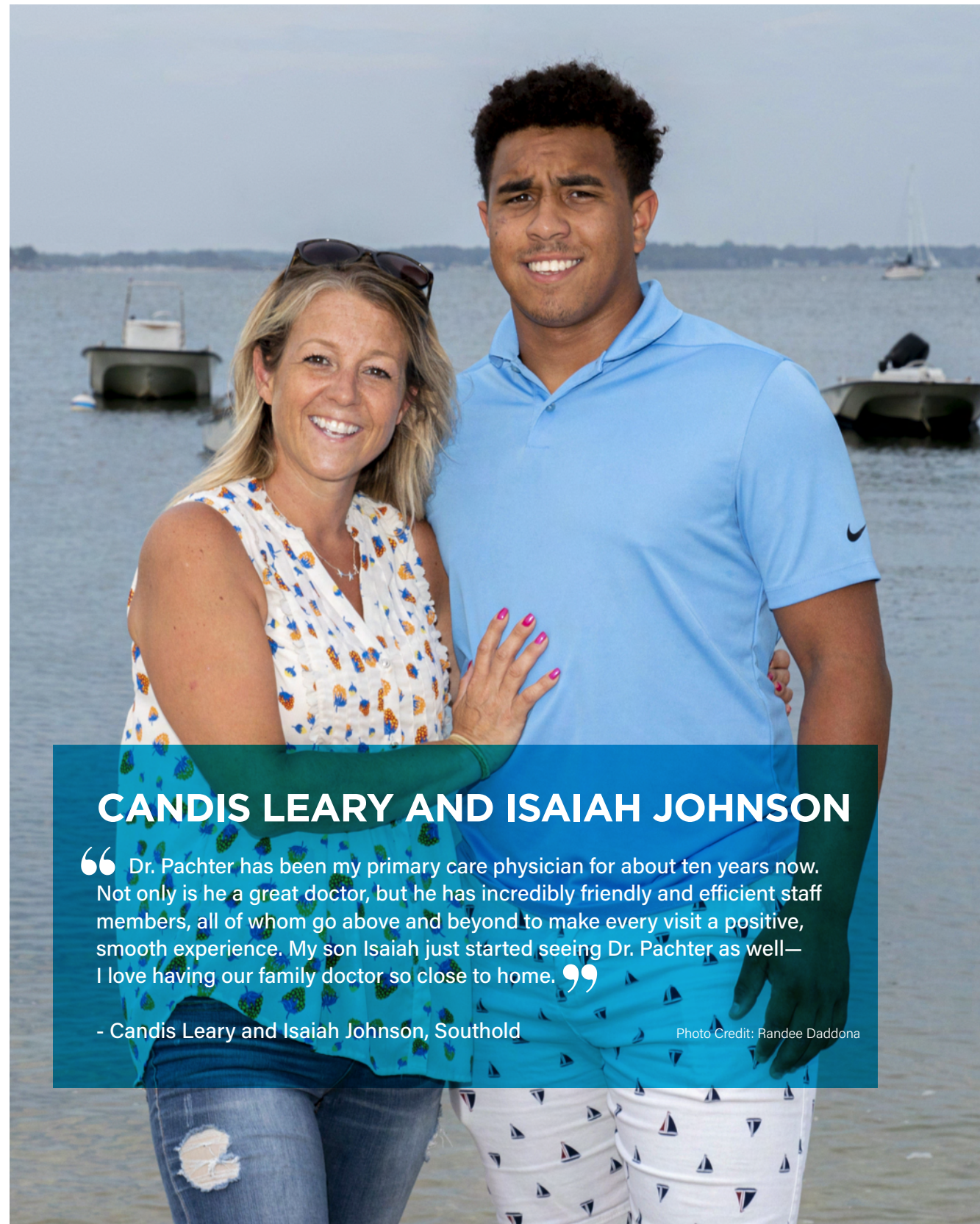
